### FOUR DOWNS

- The Apprentice School faces the first of three nationally-ranked opponents for its 2009 season opener.
- Malone was to have opened the season in Newport News last year, but Tropical Storm Hanna postponed the game. They'll open the 2010 season in Newport News.
- Apprentice School is 5-4 in season openers over the last nine years.
- First season opener against a postseason team since 1997 when they opened with 1996 NCAA Division III National Champion Rowan University. Malone played in the NCCAA Victory Bowl in 2007 and 2008.

Senior RB Joe Peters returns to lead the offense this season following a stellar junior campaign in which he collected All-MSFA Mideast First Team accolades after racking up 950 rushing yards on 166 carries (5.7 average) to go with 16 catches for 129 yards and 11 touchdowns (nine rushing, two receiving)...Although the Malone offense will feature a new QB this season, junior TE Chris Carpinelli is back to provide a reliable target for the new signal caller...Last season as a sophomore, Carpinelli compiled 16 catches for 134 yards and one touchdown...LBs Wesley Kauffman and Matt Vick both return to help lead the way on the defensive side of the ball...Kauffman, a junior, entered the starting lineup midway through the year last year and took full advantage of his opportunity, ending the season ranked among Malone's tackling leaders with 41 total stops...Vick contributed immediately as a freshman a year ago, totaling 48 tackles, including 7.5 tackles for loss, two sacks and two fumble recoveries.

## What a rank schedule

Similar to the 2008 season, the Builders face what is believed to be one of the tougher schedules they have had in recent history. Three pre-season top 25 opponents are on the slate starting with a pair in the first two games. NAIA powers Malone College (25<sup>th</sup>) and UVA Wise (21<sup>st</sup>) start off the season, before the Builders face NCAA Division III ranked Wesley (9<sup>th</sup>) in October. ACFC member Salisbury University could make it four top-25 opponents as they started the season ranked 27<sup>th</sup> in D3football.com
