The Sea Gulls

The No. 24 Salisbury University football team opened up the 2009 season with a 34-14 victory over Division II Pace University this past Saturday. SU gutted out 344 yards on the ground as the Sea Gulls amassed a total of 413 yards of offense on the day. The Sea Gulls had four different players rush for touchdowns including senior quarterback Bobby Sheahin (Brookeville, Md.), who rushed for a game-high 71 yards on 16 carries. The victory marked the ninth consecutive opening day win for SU, dating back to Sept. 1, 2001. The impressive victory catapulted SU to a No. 24 ranking in the first regular season D3football.com poll of the 2009 season.

The Series

The meeting between SU and North Carolina Wesleyan is the first ever between the two schools.

SU in the game following the season opener

Over the past seven seasons, Salisbury has dazzled its competition in the game following its season opener. SU is a perfect 7-0 in this span, which dates back to 2002, as the Sea Gulls have outscored their opponents 235-95 in seven games played. Last season, SU defeated Geneva College 48-6 in the first-ever night game played at Sea Gull Stadium.

SU has spent its second game of the year in three of the past five seasons on the road. Salisbury is 8-0 in its past eight road openers as the Sea Gulls have averaged just over 33 points per game.

Scouting North Carolina Wesleyan

North Carolina Wesleyan comes into the game with an 0-1 record after dropping a 55-23 decision at Hampden-Sydney College last Saturday afternoon. The Bishops were victimized in the contest after falling behind 41-3 after the first half.

Leading the way for NCWC is senior quarterback Bo Jordan, who was honored last season as a first team USA-South performer. Jordan averaged 231 yards passing per game last season as he threw for 2,311 yards and 15 touchdowns. In the season opener against the Tigers, Jordan connected for 191 yards and three touchdowns. His main target is senior wideout Orlando Webb, who caught six passes in the opener for 133 yards and one score.

The Bishops were picked to finish second in the 2009 preseason USA South poll. Last season, the Bishops finished with a 6-4 record, including a 5-2 record and second-place finish in the USA South. NCWC returns 15 starters to this year's team, seven of which were First Team USA South performers a year ago.

Sea Gulls move into D3football.com Top 25

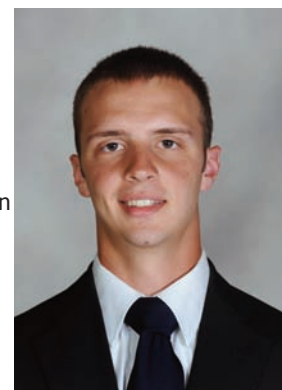
The Salisbury University football team moved into the D3football.com top 25 this week at No. 24. The Sea Gulls collected 102 points and are one of three unranked teams from the preseason poll to move into the top 25.

Defending national champion Mount Union College (1-0) retained the No. 1 spot as the Purple Raiders received 23 first-place votes and 623 points. The Purple Raiders defeated St. John Fisher 52-10 on Saturday. University of Wisconsin-Whitewater (1-0) collected two first-place votes and 602 total points in their 38-3 win over Dickinson State University. University of Mary-Hardin Baylor (0-0) remains at No. 3 with 572 points. Hardin-Simmons University (1-0) moved up one spot from No. 5 to No. 4. The Cowboys collected 515 points after their 48-31 win over Whitworth College. Wheaton (Ill.) College (0-0) rounds out the top five as the Thunder garnered 506 points.

Atlantic Central Football Conference (ACFC) member and route-13 rival Wesley College (1-0) ascended three spots from No. 9 to No. 6. The Wolverines defeated Christopher Newport University 34-0 on Saturday.

Kowalick named ACFC Special Teams Player of the Week

Salisbury University sophomore kicker Tommy Kowalick (Sterling, VA) earned Atlantic Central Football Conference (ACFC) Special Teams Player of the Week honors for his performance on Sept. 5 in the 34-14 Salisbury victory over Division II opponent Pace University.



The Sterling, Va. native, accounted for the first SU points on the day by making a 34-yard field goal with 5:43 to play in the first quarter. Kowalick was 2-for-2 in field goal attempts, and helped cap a nine-play, 69-yard drive with a 37-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter making it 20-14. He averaged 62.3 yards per kickoff, denying the Pace offense the opportunity of establishing good starting field position.

In his rookie season Kowalick won first team All-ACFC honors, when he led the conference in both field goals made (5-6), and point after attempt success rate (95 percent). In 2008, he scored 60 points for the Sea Gulls, and averaged 52.9 yards per kickoff.

Cynewski, Lanham, Sheahin named SU Players of the Week

Each week the Salisbury University coaching staff names their offensive, defensive and special teams Players of the Week. Following the Pace University game, senior captains Paul Cynewski (defense) and Bobby Sheahin (offense) claimed the honors along with sophomore Colin Lanham, who was named the Special Teams Player of the Week.

Sheahin ran for a game-high 71 yards and a touchdown while Cynewski added a pair of sacks and Lanham made strong plays in coverage on the kicking teams last Saturday.

What's Next?

Salisbury then travels to play Christopher Newport on Sept. 19. Last season SU defeated the Captains by a score of 38-21 at Sea Gull Stadium. The Salisbury football team does not return home until Sept. 26, when they host St. John Fisher at noon.



Established in 1977 in fond memory of a young man who gave himself freely and unselfishly to the "Boys" and Salisbury State College by his efforts on and off the football field, the Bobby Richards Memorial Award is presented annually to the Salisbury University player or players that provide spirit and inspiration to Salisbury football and shows love and compassion for others as well as demonstrates courage, determination, dedication and perseverance. Bobby Richards was a member of Salisbury's first varsity football team in 1973 and played through 1977. In 2008, the Sea Gulls honored quarterback **Ronnie Curley** with the award.
