**THE SERIES:** Saturday's game marks the first ever meeting between the two schools. The Wolverines were set to travel to Christopher Newport last season before the game was wiped out by Tropical Storm Hanna.

**POSTSEASON SUCCESS:** Wesley is making its fourth consecutive trip to the NCAA Division III Championship and fifth in program history. In the past three years, the Wolverines have won nine postseason games to rank third in Division III in behind only Mount Union and UW-Whitewater in playoff wins during that time.

**SCOUTING THE CAPTAINS:** The Captains of Christopher Newport are coming off an 8-2 season in 2008, and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the 6th time in eight years of program history. CNU lost at Washington & Jefferson ( 35-29) in the first round of the NCAA Tournament to conclude the 2008 season, which included an eight-game winning streak, the longest in program history.

**OFFENSE...** The Captains were led by All American running back Tunde Ogun, who will return for his senior season in 2009. Ogun was the USA South's Offensive Player of the Year and broke school and conference records last season by rushing for 1794 yards. He also set a single-game rushing record by running for 283 yards on 36 carries at North Carolina Wesleyan.

Nationally last season, Ogun achieved all-America status and finished third in the country in rushing. He was also all-state and named state Player of the Year by the Touchdown Club of Richmond and the Richmond Times-Dispatch. For his career, Ogun has rushed for 2466 yards on 401 carries in 18 games at CNU, which is now second on the all-time CNU career rushing list behind only Roland Hilliard (3149 yards). Ogun for his career is averaging 137 yards rushing per game and 6.1 yards per carry.

**DEFENSE...** Christopher Newport has eight returning starters on defense for the 2009 season.

The Captains return a very experienced and talented group at the linebacker spots. Adrin Diggs and Chris Nickle along with sophomore Mike King will play at inside spots. Senior Jay Kirland and junior Bryan Vaughan return to play the outside. CNU also returns a solid group in the defensive backfield. Three juniors (Randell Bronte-Tinkew, Ryan Wever, and Dominik Taylor) and sophomore Markis Kelly give the Captains experienced starters at all four spots.

Christopher Newport's defensive front was hit hard by graduation, but senior Trevor Wagner and junior Kyle Krupp have contributed in the past and are no strangers to the job. Junior Bryan Oliver and sophomore Carlos Canales will likely have significant roles.

**HEAD COACH...** Matt Kelchner returns for his 9th season as Head Coach. His eight year record is 57-27 (.679) and is a four-time USA South Coach of the Year. Originally from Harrisburg, PA, Kelchner made a coaching stop at Mansfield University in 1982 where Wesley Head Coach Mike Drass earned his degree.

**CONFERENCE EXCELLENCE:** Wesley's win over Salisbury clinched the 2008 ACFC Championship for the Wolverines. It gave Wesley an unprecedented fourth straight conference crown.

Since the Atlantic Central Football Conference's inception in 1998, Wesley has won at least a share of the title seven times in 11 years. With five undefeated ACFC seasons including 2008, the Wolverines have more perfect conference records than the rest of the members combined.

Wesley is 15-1 (.938) in ACFC play in its current four-year run.

**UNDER CENTER:** Since taking over as the starting quarterback in the season's second game last year, junior quarterback Shane McSweeney has been exceptional. He finished 2008 ranked second in the NCAA Division III with a pass efficiency of 181.17. He has

completed 130-of-193 passes for 2003 yards and 18 touchdowns against just four interceptions (2.1 percent). His efforts earned him the ACFC Offensive Player of the Year Award as he set new a new school and conference record in pass efficiency and a new Wesley mark by completing 67 percent of his passes. McSweeney, from Bensalem, Pennsylvania, has thrown for multiple touchdowns in six of his 10 starts. He's also shown the ability to use his feet, rushing for 99 yards against Iona, 77 more against Salisbury and 53 last week at Muhlenberg.

After going 14-of-17 for 289 yards and three touchdowns against Frostburg State on October 4, McSweeney was named the Atlantic Central Football Conference Offensive Player of the Week. He earned the award again after passing for 211 yards on 8-of-10 passing and two touchdowns against Lake Erie.

**GETTING DEFENSIVE:** The Wesley College defense ranked in the top 20 in Division III in total defense and scoring defense. The Wolverines were 16th in D3 allowing just 265.36 total yards per game. Not surprisingly, the low yardage totals translated into low point totals for opponents as the Wolverines surrendered just 15.00 points per game, 16th in Division III.

**LONGPLAYS:** The Wesley offense was ripping off big plays at will against Lake Erie College last October. The Wolverines had their two longest pass plays of the year, including the long of 59 yards for a touchdown from Shane McSweeney to Larry Beavers. Mike Pennewell's 81-yard touchdown run was the longest rush of the season and Beavers' 80-yard punt return was also the long by a Wesley player in 2008.

**MOVETHECHAINS:** Wesley was very successful on third down last season. The Wolverines are converting 48 percent (60-of-124) of its third down opportunities. The mark broke its previous school and ACFC record of 44 percent (84-191) in 2005.

**MAYBELATER:** The first half has belonged to Wesley in 2008. The Wolverines outscored their opponents 235-46 over the first 30 minutes last season. Wesley entered the half with an average lead of over 17 points per game.

**NOADVANCE:** Wesley set an NCAA record last season by allowing a negative five punt return yards and ranked eighth in Division III in net punting at 35.74.

**FORSTARTERS:** Wesley is 16-3 on opening day since 1990.

**NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS:** Wesley has enjoyed a great deal of success outside the ACFC in recent seasons. Since the start of the 2004 season, the Wolverines are 32-7 (.816) against non-conference opponents. Wesley is 18-2 (.900) in conference play over that time.

**ACTION JACKSON:** Senior Aaron Jackson became the seventh Wolverine with at least 2,000 yards after rushing for 100 against Iona on October 11 last season. He enters the 2009 season sixth on the all-time list with 2,486 yards. Jackson can climb further up the ladder quickly, with just 269 yards separating him from third in Wesley's record book. He is tied for eighth in rushing touchdowns with 20 in his career. His next rushing touchdown will vault him into a tie for fourth.

**THAT'S OFFENSIVE:** Wesley ranked 25th in scoring offense in Division III last season, averaging 35.09 points per game.

**BETTER WITH AGE:** Since ascending to Division III in 1986, Wesley has increased both its win total and win percentage every decade. Despite still having a year left in the 2000s, the Wolverines have still won a school record 80 games in the decade.

**SHARED OPPONENTS:** The Captains next game is against Route 13 rival Salisbury University. Although Wesley doesn't play the Seagulls until October 31st, comparisons will likely be made.

**YOU GOT MY VOTE:** Both Wesley and CNU garnered pre-season attention in the National Polls. Here's a quick breakdown: USA Today - Wesley #11, CNU #21; The Sporting News - CNU #14, Wesley #15; and d3football.com - Wesley #9, CNU #20.

**NO PICKS FOR YOU:** Wesley College did not throw an interception in its first four games and has just four all season in 231 attempts (1.7 percent).

**NO PLACE LIKE HOME:** Wesley has been particularly tough playing on its home field since having FieldTurf installed prior to the 2004 season. Since that time, the Wolverines are 32-2 at the Dr. Scott D. Miller Stadium (.941). Over their past 51 home games dating back to the start of the 2000 season, Wesley is 44-8 on its home field (.846).

**MAKE HASTE, NOT WASTE:** The Wesley offense has scored a touchdown on its first possession in eight of its 11 games this season.
